One person may nominate one eligible blog, one eligible website and one eligible Facebook page. The Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to determine whether a nominated blog, website or Facebook page is eligible for selection and to disqualify at any time any nominated blog, website or Facebook page which it considers to be in violation of any laws and/or ineligible in any other way.
